OUR PROGRAMS





Support Connecting Survivors, Thrivers and Co-Survivors to share, grow, and laugh within a safe community of understanding and camaraderie. Group sessions include social gatherings, empowerment activities, and more.

One-on-One Mentoring is the centerpiece of our Support Program. We match Survivors & Thrivers with a Mentor who has a similar diagnosis and treatment history and can walk alongside them in their journey.



Education Connecting Survivors & Thrivers with leading doctors, medical researchers, educators, and healthcare professionals that help with navigating the breast cancer experience.



Wellness Addressing the mind-body needs of breast cancer Survivors & Thrivers. Group sessions include exercise, yoga, and mindfulness. Personalized Sessions, provide one-on-one services by certified practitioners of oncology massage, fascial stretching, myofascial release therapy and more.



Nutrition Teaching Survivors & Thrivers the science of nutrition and healthy eating. Group Sessions include cooking classes, and we're proud to offer access to Novant Health's Healing Kitchens online course.



Self-Image Providing Survivors & Thrivers with self-care techniques tailored to their unique needs. Group Sessions include wig-care tips, skin care, and more.

Providing **free wigs, prostheses, and mastectomy bras** is a centerpiece of our Self-image Program. Survivors & Thrivers can visit the Pink House to get these items that help restore their sense of self.

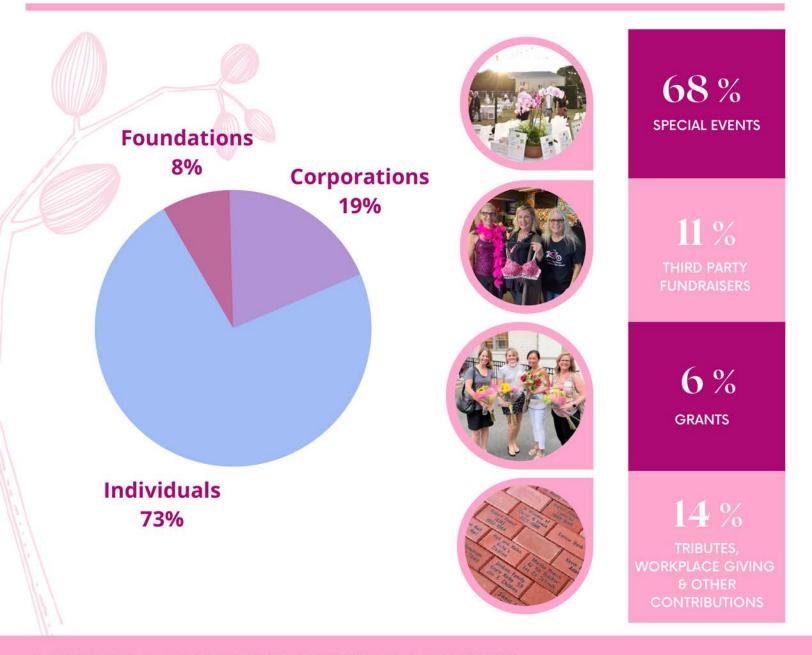

SURVIVOR SERVING SURVIVORS ANNIE

As a breast cancer Survivor and a hairstylist, Annie felt inspired to merge both aspects of her life and create The Pink Hair Studio. Beyond doing beautiful color and haircuts, she believes her purpose is to comfortably and confidently help women with cancer through the hair loss and regrowth process.

For every haircut service, Annie donates \$5 to Carolina Breast Friends.

"It fills my heart to connect with so many inspiring women and give back to an organization close to my heart," says Annie.

Annie found CBF after relocating to Charlotte last June upon finishing her treatments. Nervous about finding a new medical team and support system, Annie happened upon CBF through a Google search. She says, "When I read and saw what CBF does for women with breast cancer, I knew I wanted to jump in and help give back."

At 37-years-old, breast cancer was a journey Annie never imagined she'd be on. Having lived it, she felt very strongly about helping others. "Carolina Breast Friends has given me the opportunity to do so," she says.

"I was inspired to find ways I could help contribute to this organization."

Caroline knew she could make an impact on Survivors, but she wasn't sure how. Upon some brainstorming, she decided to put her talents in the kitchen to good use.

So, Caroline decided to sell chocolate covered strawberries, Oreos, pretzels, and candies. The profits from her sales went to purchase items needed for comfort bags. "To date, I have completed 25 bags and am close to completing 25 more."

In addition to the comfort bags, Caroline has provided chocolate treats as favors for several CBF Survivor events including Mother's Day, Thankful Feast, and the Ugly Sweater Holiday Party.

"I have been designing and making jewelry for the last nine years," says Stuart, who is pleased to add, "For the last eight years I have been teaching the jewelry class at CBF on a monthly basis."

Not only does Stuart give back by volunteering his time and talent to Survivors for our jewelry-making sessions, he also gives back by donating 100% of stuART designs' jewelry sales back to CBF.

Personalized sessions are one-on-one therapeutic sessions delivered by experienced practitioners with specialized training in their fields.



Provides 1 Survivor with Support Programs

Our programs are tailored to the needs of the breast cancer community. We provide over 20 sessions per month, including in-person, virtual, and on-demand videos on YouTube.



Provides a Wig or a Bra & Prosthesis

We offer self-image items at The Pink House. When a Survivor is ready, we have an assortment of head scarves, wigs, mastectomy bras and prosthesis for selection.



Provides a Comfort Bag

A Comfort Bag includes essentials for someone going through breast cancer chemotherapy. We also provide a post-surgery pillow and an Inspiration Jar filled with quotes from our mentors.
